# The New City Catechism

The New City Catechism is a modern-day resource aimed at helping children and adults learn the core doctrines of the Christian faith using 52 questions and answers.

### Part 2: Christ, Redemption, Grace

### **QUESTION 28**

# What happens after death to those not united to Christ by faith?

At the day of judgment they will receive the fearful but just sentence of condemnation pronounced against them. They will be cast out from the favorable presence of God, into hell, to be justly and grievously punished, forever.

> For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. . . . Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

# Summer Challenge

During the summer months, it is easy to get off track with your daily walk with the Lord because of vacations, summer activities, and busyness. So, this summer, to help us stay on track, we want to **challenge our church to do three things:** 

# 1. Pray For One Lost Person Daily

- Pray that they will somehow hear the gospel each day.
- Pray that God will awaken their hearts to their need for Him.
- Pray that God will give you the words to say when you share the gospel with them.
- Pray that God will grant that they will have ears to hear, faith to believe, and the desire to respond to the gospel.

# 2. Pursue One Lost Person

• Begin/continue a relationship with one person that does not have a relationship with Jesus Christ. Remember, sometime people can be led to Jesus the first time you see and visit with them. However, most people are brought to Jesus by a friend or relative. Work at making friends with lost people.

# 3. Present The Gospel

- Sharing the Gospel is where the power comes from. Make sure your presentation is clear, concise, and compelling.
- Use what God has done in your life as a real example for them to see and understand.
- Utilize whatever way that you are comfortable in sharing your faith.
